We are really excited about our after school clubs programme for the Summer 1 half term. Due to the success of clubs this term we have decided they will remain the same, although different children can sign up to take part in them. Due to high demand we have also introduced football as an additional club.

<p>Wednesday* Football Starting: Wednesday 18th April 3:30-4:30pm</p>	<p>Delivered by external football coaches who are also PE teachers and hold level 1 and 2 FA coaching badges. See attached leaflet about Easter holiday provision.</p>
<p>Thursday* Multisports Starting: Thursday 19th April 3:30-4:30pm</p>	<p>A range of ball games and skills. Children will try out a range of sports, skills and drills!</p>
<p>*This will require the children to have their PE kit in school on club day to change into after school</p>	

Each club costs £20 for the half term. Similar to last term, payment and signup will be through Parent Pay. The option to sign up and pay a £5 deposit for a club will appear on your account. Places are limited to 15 children per club, so please sign up before Tuesday 3rd April to avoid disappointment. After children have signed up we will request the remaining payment of £15 through Parent Pay and this can be made in installments.

If you need to activate your parent account, please speak to reception and we can provide login details again. Please ensure you have paid any current outstanding balances on your account to be able to sign up your child for clubs next term.

We do not wish to deny any child from taking part in any club due to financial reasons so please speak to your child’s form tutor or myself if you have any concerns with the above.

Children will be learning skills that will build on each other each week so they need to commit to coming for a half term. We cannot provide any refund if your child is unable to attend a session due to illness, absence or a session has to be cancelled.

Children must follow the expectations of the instructor during these sessions to ensure that they can continue to participate. Please ensure your child is picked up on time at 4:30pm.

By signing up for a club on Parent Pay, you are agreeing for your child to take part in the activity and suffers from no medical conditions that may prevent them from taking part. Please acknowledge this when you sign up on Parent Pay using the notes box.
