Core Knowledge



Rigorous Academic Curriculum: we place a strong emphasis on laying solid foundations in key subjects - building powerful knowledge so that our children have access to 'the best that's been thought and said.'

Learning First: our adults and children are committed to being better every day. We shape how children learn with intelligent curriculum design and extensive use of formative assessment. If it doesn't help children learn, we don't do it. Our home learning videos and tools help parents boost learning at home.

Powerful feedback: regular, powerful feedback increases student learning. Our teachers receive weekly coaching and practise key teaching skills in deliberate practise sessions every single week. We are always positive about our next steps.



Driven by Data: following regular analysis of data of what children can or can't do, we tailor lessons to target whole class, small group and I-I intervention to improve learning. Our lessons are tailored to answer the question 'did my children learn it' rather than 'did I teach it'.



Character Attributes - STRIVE



Character: from day I, through our unique STRIVE curriculum, we instill and develop in our students character strengths and attributes which help them lead successful and fulfilled lives.



High Expectations: we expect pupils to work hard and be respectful at all times. We have high expectations for behaviour, uniform and politeness. We 'sweat the small stuff' because we know that excellence is achieved step by step - One Degree at a time.



SEMH: We work with world leading experts from The Anna Freud Centre to help our parents and teachers develop our children's executive function and emotional resilience.



Parents as partners: we see parents as partners. Weekly class videos, powerful home learning resources and regular progress updates keep parents informed so they can support at home. The One Degree Parenthub - including family learning and free expert psychotherapy - support parents when things are hard.



Small: our school is small with only 30 students currently in each year group, meaning every student is individually known and cared for

Culture of High Aspiration: our students are regularly exposed to world-leading universities, businesses and organisations. From Reception, they are encouraged to aim high.



VIP lunch and Careers programme: every week, every child meets with an external speaker from a different career to open their eyes to new opportunities and possibilities.



Enrichment: we offer a unique enrichment curriculum to develop the whole child: all students take part in Sports, Spanish, Music, taught by specialists. Farming, volunteering, study of the arts and regular trips and the arts are an entitlement for all.
